**A.** For each of the following parties, memorise the number of MPs, and the % share of the vote:

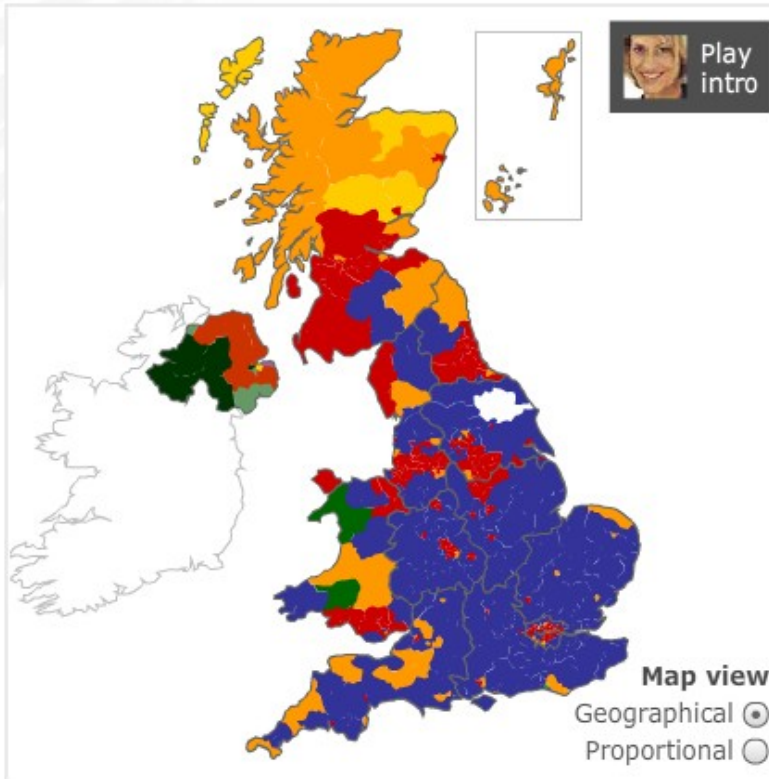
