Pupils learn about the dangers of alcohol

Our pupils are among the first in the UK to participate in a national project that makes them more aware of the dangers of alcohol misuse.

The school is particularly grateful to **The Butlins Resort** in Bognor Regis for nominating us for the *Schools Alcohol Awareness Project*. Their support for the scheme has ensured our classes receive teaching materials which help pupils learn in a fun and imaginative way.

The initiative is backed by **BII**, a registered charity and the professional body for the licensed retail sector. **BII** works with its members throughout the UK to promote responsible attitudes to alcohol consumption and retail by generating greater awareness of social and legal responsibilities.

As part of the **BII Schools Project**, pupils tackle quizzes and puzzles which teach about the health and social problems caused by the irresponsible use of alcohol.
